CIVIC BUILDERS AWARDED LET'S PLAY GRANT FOR IMAGINATION PLAYGROUND™ PLAY SYSTEM FROM DR PEPPER SNAPPLE GROUP AND Kaboom!

Cumberland, Rhode Island, September 13, 2014 – Dr Pepper Snapple Group (DPS) and national non-profit KaBOOM! awarded Civic Builders a Let's Play Community Construction Grant to use toward an Imagination Playground in a Cart™ playground for Blackstone Valley Prep Mayoral Academy Elementary School 2 in Cumberland, RI.
